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Competitive Edge Racing School 2011 - "Test of the Best" Rules and Regulations

SECTION I

Program

Test of the Best

The "Test of the Best" is offered by Competitive Edge Racing School in conjunction with the Competitive Edge Race Series and is the only one of its kind in the country. The intent of the event is to provide participants the opportunity to be evaluated in various levels of racing abilities, general knowledge, coachability, and presentability. The Competitive Edge Racing School will then award the best participants in an attempt to assist them in beginning, or furthering their racing efforts.

The event is scheduled over 4 days including classroom time and on-track sessions. The first day will include registration, a two-hour classroom session held at the racetrack, and three 25-lap on-track sessions for each participant in our purpose built late model stock cars. The Second day will consist of another 2-hour classroom session at the track with each participant taking part in qualifying, starts and re-starts, and passing exercises. The final on-track lapping session allows the participant to try to combine all of their experiences.

On Day three of the event each driver will be entered into the first event of the 2011 Championship Race Series. The first day of the weekend's Race Series will consist of (two) 25-lap practice sessions and qualifying. The final day of the event will consist of a final practice session and (two) 25-lap races.

Each participant is scored points throughout the entire test in all of the above aspects on & off the track. The participant that accumulates the most points will be the winner of the "Test of the Best" and awarded the grand prize.

Eligibility & Requirements

To participate in the **Competitive Edge Racing School "Test of the Best"** program you must;

- a. Be at least 18 years of age no later than the date of the event.

(Driver's under the age of 18 and at least 16 years of age with a valid driver's license will be considered on a case by case basis. A minor's release is required to be signed by both legal parents.)

- b. Have a valid driver's license.
- c. Have not competed in more than two Competitive Edge Race Series events previously.

The event will be limited to the first 12 accepted registrants. In the event that more than 12 participants wish to participate, and there are enough participants to fill a second test date, Competitive Edge Racing School at its discretion, may extend the test. In the event that two separate test dates are conducted Competitive Edge Racing School may invite back the top three to five from each test (at the expense of Competitive Edge less travel) to determine the winner.

Registrations will begin at 8:30am P.S.T. on January 2nd. You may make a deposit of \$500 to hold a space and the price of \$1895 as long as final payment is made no later than May 1st. Payment must be received in full in order to secure your space in the program. If you have only made a deposit and another participant is ready to purchase the final seat in the event you will be contacted and must make payment promptly to secure your space.

Cancellation Policy

Due to the fact that the “Test of the Best” program is a racing school and a competition, the registrant understands that if the program, for any reason is cancelled by the registrant, or registrant fails to attend for any reason, any and all payments made to Competitive Edge will be forfeited. If a suitable replacement can be scheduled then any payments, less an administration and rebooking fee of \$500 as a non-refundable deposit, may be returned. The Competitive Edge Racing School reserves the right to reschedule or cancel the scheduled program (i.e. track repairs, etc.) or revise the program at any time. In the event Competitive Edge cancels the program date for which you are scheduled for any reason, the event will be rescheduled or an event of comparable value will be replaced.

THERE ARE NO REFUNDS.

Prizes & Awards

The Test of the Best program is designed to find the best participant with the most opportunity to be successful in racing. The Competitive Edge Racing School will then award the best participants in an attempt to assist them in beginning their racing efforts. Each participant is scored points throughout the test. The participant that accumulates the most points will be the winner of the “Test of the Best” and awarded the grand prize.

- a. Grand Prize - Awarded to the participant who accumulates the most points.

SECTION II

Safety Equipment Requirements

Competitive Edge Racing School and Race Series programs involve high speeds and driving in traffic situations with drivers of varying experience, ability, and speed, racing can be and is a dangerous activity, which can result in serious or fatal injuries. The following is a list of safety equipment required to participate in either "Test of the Best", "Practice Days", or "Race Series" activities. It is recommended that each driver furnish his/her own equipment however, Competitive Edge Racing School equipment is available. The driving suits are Sparco two-layer Nomex. The helmets are RaceQuip Ridgeline Snell approved SA-2005 Nomex lined helmets. This equipment may be adequate for the general usage and purpose that it is intended for, but it may not provide the highest level of safety and protection available. Gloves, shoes, and head socks are not available and are the responsibility of the participant. Usage of the Competitive Edge Racing School equipment constitutes an acceptance of the safety and protection level of the equipment.

IF THE PARTICIPANT IS PROVIDING HIS/HER OWN EQUIPMENT, IT IS THE PARTICIPANTS RESPONSIBILITY TO FURNISH AND WEAR COMPLIANT EQUIPMENT AT ALL TIMES. NO EQUIPMENT COMPLIANCE INSPECTIONS WILL BE PERFORMED.

1. Helmet

Required - A Snell DOT rating. **Recommended**; A Snell 2005SA rating, Nomex lined, full face with impact resistant shield. (have clear and tinted with you). *It is strongly recommended that the back of each drivers helmet be labeled as follows, name, date of birth, blood type, allergies, date of last tetanus immunization and any other pertinent medical history (i.e., diabetes, etc.)*

2. Driving Suit

Required - One-piece suit covering the body from the ankles to the neck made of a minimum one layer of fire resistant material such as; Nomex or equivalent material. PROBAN OR POLY COTTON material is NOT acceptable. **Recommended**; A multi layer (2 or more layers), Nomex or equivalent, one piece driving suits with underwear made of similar material.

3. Gloves

Required - Gloves made of leather, fire resistant material, or "mechanics" gloves (i.e., "Ringers Resource" or "Mechanix") **Recommended**; gloves made of Nomex or equivalent fire resistant material.

4. Shoes

Required - Shoes with uppers made of leather and/or nonflammable material (i.e., leather tennis shoes). Nylon shoes are not acceptable. **Recommended**; shoes made of Nomex or equivalent fire resistant material.

5. Head Sock (balaclava)

Required - A head sock is required if you are using an open-faced or nylon lined helmet or a helmet not lined with Nomex or equivalent fire resistant material. **Recommended**; for all drivers and any driver with a beard or mustache or hair protruding from beneath the helmet.

The following items are strongly **Recommended**.

Socks - Made of Nomex or equivalent fire resistant material.

Neck Collar - Highly recommended.

Head & Neck Restraint - Security Race Products, Hutchens, or Hans devices.

Seat Padding - For those who wish to customize their seating, please bring your own foam padding.

(The above schedule is tentative and may change from time to time. Schedule updates and changes may be required and will be updated and reviewed at the Driver's Meetings.)

2. Rain Policy

In the event of rain we will make every attempt to dry the track and perform all scheduled track time however, the event and or track time may be shortened in-order to complete. If the day or the event is declared a total "rain-out" (called at the sole discretion of the lead instructor), the missed track time will be rescheduled at the earliest convenient time for Competitive Edge Racing School and the facility. (possibly as early as Saturday or Sunday) The track time may or may not be rescheduled at the same facility.

REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GRANTED.

3. Track Rules

- a. Everyone entering the pit area will need to sign the release form at registration and wear a provided wristband at all times.
- b. You must be a minimum of 16 years of age in order to enter the pit area. Persons under the age of 18 will need to have a minor's release signed by a parent or legal guardian.

- c. No personal vehicles will be allowed in the pit area. All personal vehicles will need to be parked in the main parking lot or designated parking area.
- d. No personal bicycles, ATV's, or motorcycles will be allowed in the pit area.
- e. At the drivers meeting a designated safe wall will be determined. Everyone must stay behind the safe wall. No one will enter the racetrack or cross the racetrack with vehicles on the racing surface. Those persons wishing to cross the racetrack will do so when approved for crossing by the flag stand official.

4. Car Selection

- a. All of the racecars have adjustable seats and should fit most participants.
- b. The Crew Chief will assign each driver a car that will be used in each of the on-track sessions. In the event of a mechanical failure a back-up car will be provided. It is important that each driver remain with their designated car for the entire event for scoring purposes.

5. Test Rules

- a. Each driver will participate in the four day test, which will include on-track, classroom sessions, written and oral evaluations.
- b. The first day of on-track time will consist of (three) 25-lap track sessions. The second day, each driver will participate in a qualifying session, starts and restart drills, and a passing exercise. The day will conclude with a final 25-lap track session.
- c. Day's three and four each driver will participate in the first event of the 2011 Championship Race Series.
- d. There will be absolutely no outside radio communication or coaching with a driver other than by CERS staff at any time.
- e. Each driver will be scored points and graded in all aspects of the test which may include but is not limited to the on-track sessions, written exams, oral and or video interviews, communication, and marketable evaluations.
- f. The total accumulation of points will determine the winner of the test. The instructing and evaluation staff will have the final say and is not subject to interpretation or confrontation. Every effort will be made to tally the points on the final day of the event but total points tallies are not official until 5 days after the event.
- g. Any attempt to directly or indirectly cause deception, jeopardize, or affect another driver's score will result in immediate disqualification.

SECTION IV

Damage Liability

In a perfect world, every driver would have incident free on-track sessions, constantly improve, and never cause damage to the racecars or equipment. However in the event that an accident occurs, the participant understands that; the participant will be held liable for the cost of repairing the damage to the racecars, racetrack, equipment, or facility that was damaged in the accident. The participant will then make arrangements for payment of such prior to leaving the racetrack.

At Competitive Edge we try to take some of the sting out of the realities of racing. We know that many of the people who would get involved in racing would decide against it if they had a potential liability of \$30,000 (the cost of one of our racecars). So we have created the opportunity to purchase an insurance type program to further limit a driver's liability.

1. **Damage Liability Policy**

This is an insurance styled policy that is offered by Competitive Edge to further reduce the potential sting of possible crash damage. By purchasing the policy the driver will only be responsible for the deductible amount.

Competitive Edge reserves the right to make the Damage Liability Policy non-available to drivers that are considered to be a High-Risk.

2. **Damage Invoices**

Prior to the end of, or within a week of the event, an estimated or completed invoice for damages incurred will be presented to the Driver. It is the driver's responsibility to make payment or arrangements for payment in accordance with the estimate prior to leaving the racetrack. Upon receiving the completed invoice the driver will then have 10 days to pay the invoice or make payment arrangements with Competitive Edge.

SECTION V

Participant / Driver Acknowledgment and Agreement

The Driver's signature on the "Driver Acknowledgement and Agreement" form constitutes that the driver specifically consents that:

- a. The Instructing Staff or the President of the Competitive Edge Racing School will have the final word on any disputes, disagreements, or interpretation of the rules and is not subject to negotiation or confrontation. The Competitive Edge Racing School reserves the right to change or cause change to the rules at anytime. The driver and his/her successor's, agent's, present or future attorney's, or representative's will hold harmless the Competitive Edge Racing School staff, it's owners, officers, directors, agents, attorneys, insurers, employees, track, landowners, assigns, successors in interest, personal representatives, administrators and any other person or organization associated with the Competitive Edge Racing School and track from any and all claims, actions or suits, whether past, present, or future, whether known or unknown, and asserted or unasserted.
- b. Any and all disputes and claims between the Driver and Competitive Edge Racing School relating to payment of fees, penalties, crash damage or any other related expenses will be decided by the Competitive Edge Racing School. In the event legal resolution is required the Courts of the State of Idaho (Kootenai County) will have jurisdiction as though the related event or debt had been conducted or incurred entirely within the State of Idaho (Kootenai County).
- c. The Driver agrees to personal jurisdiction of the Courts of the State of Idaho (Kootenai County) and any judgement rendered by the courts may be enforced by any court any where in the United States or abroad where that Driver may be found.

I understand that usage of school provided equipment is an acceptance of the safety and protection level of the equipment.

RAIN POLICY

In the event of rain we will make every attempt to dry the track and perform all scheduled track time however, the event and or track time may be shortened in-order to complete. If the day or the event is declared a total "rain-out" (called at the sole discretion of the lead instructor), the missed track time will be rescheduled at the earliest convenient time for Competitive Edge Racing School and the facility. The track time may or may not be rescheduled at the same facility. REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GRANTED.

DAMAGE LIABILITY POLICY

Except for very rare exceptions, damage to the racecars is unlikely and preventable. However in the event that an accident occurs, I understand that; I will be held liable for the cost of repairing the damage to the race cars, race track, equipment, or facility that was damaged in the accident, and will make arrangements for payment of such prior to leaving the race track. I also understand that, an insurance-styled program providing for a \$1200.00 deductible is offered by Competitive Edge Racing School. For the "Test of the Best" program the policy fee is \$200.00. By electing to purchase the Damage Liability Policy you will only be responsible for the deductible amount in the event of an accident.
